



Meyersdale Elks Lodge No. 1951 Scholarship Program

Criteria

- An award of \$250 each will be presented to one male and 1 female eligible student.
- The student must show proof of post-high school education and whose parent ^{grandparent} is a current paid member in good standing in the year of the application and the succeeding year of Meyersdale Elks Lodge No. 1951.
- A letter of acceptance from a 4-year, 2-year, business, trade or technical school must be submitted with the application.
- The applicant must provide a brief resume of community or church service designating hours spent and signed by an individual where the service has been performed.
- A transcript must be provided after the 1st semester of school showing at least a 2.0 GPA or equivalent and a full-time status of 12 credits per semester or its equivalent before the award will be given.
- Applications for the awards will be obtainable after April 1 from the Meyersdale Elks Lodge and must be returned to the Meyersdale Elks Lodge by May 15 of each year. Only one application per student will be accepted per year.
- Eligibility for the awards will be determined by the scholarship committee which will consist of one member from the Youth Activities Committee, one member from the Bingo Committee, one at-large Lodge member and the Exalted Ruler as an ex-officio member.
- Winner(s) of the scholarship will be determined by a random drawing of eligible applicants at the second Lodge meeting in May.
- A person can only receive an award one time. If an eligible applicant is not selected, they may reapply in another year as long as they are still maintaining full-time status up to a maximum of four years.
- If the recipient fails to meet the criteria, the award will remain in the fund for future awards.
