1. Be on time – if you are not in your assigned seat when the bell rings you will be marked TARDY! (3rd time= referral)

Technology Policies

Consequences

1. Warning or conference after class.

Passes -

Asking for passes should not cause a disruption in class. Library and tutoring passes should be requested BEFORE or AFTER class or during quiet classwork times. Bathroom and locker passes should be kept to a minimum (also do not disrupt class to ask for one unless it is an emergency.)
