



READING

- We use the Wonders Reading Series.
- I teach the Pennsylvania Core 4th grade standards and eligible content through the reading book and other resources that I find online and paper and pencil.
- · Grades will be taken from classwork, vocabulary and comprehension tests.





WRITING

- Writing in fourth grade mainly focuses on the TDA (Text Dependent Analysis). This is an essay that is written in response to a prompt after reading a passage. The essay must use use text evidence and an analysis of why that evidence supports the answer.
- · We will also do narrative, descriptive, and persuasive writing pieces throughout the year.

GRAMMAR

YOU'RE

- Fourth grade grammar will focus on PA core standards and eligible content.
- · Skills taught will include sentence structure, parts of speech, and correct usage.
- · l expect complete sentences in all written work.
- · Grades will be taken from classwork, quizzes, and tests.

SPELLING



- · I give a spelling test each week.
- Spelling words may be from the Wonders Reading Series, or from other content words
- · I do not give practice spelling tests.
- · I expect correct spelling on all written work to the best of the student's ability.
- · Grades will be taken from weekly spelling tests.

DAILY FOLDERS/PLANNERS

- Your child will have a blue Daily Folder and a Planner. Please check both daily.
- The Daily folder will have homework, notes from the school, and returned work in it. This folder should stay organized and be cleaned out regularly.
- · Your child will write homework and upcoming and important events in their Planner. This can also be a place to write a quick note to me.



HOMEWORK

- I do not believe in giving a lot of homework. I like for the kids to do their work in class so that I can be there if they need assistance.
- Homework may consist of spelling practice book pages, studying for quizzes and tests, and occasionally work not finished in class.
- If you ever feel that the amount of homework is overwhelming, please let me know.



GRADING

• The grading scale at Rockwood is as follows:



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90 - 100% --- A
80 - 89% --- B
70 - 79% --- C
65 - 69% --- D
Below 64% --- F
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- Grades are posted in Power Schools
- Progress reports are sent home approximately every 3 weeks.
- Report cards are sent home every 9 weeks.
