...when our service men and women and our veterans turn to Red Cross volunteers to help them and their families through the struggles that can occur during times of deployment and national emergencies.

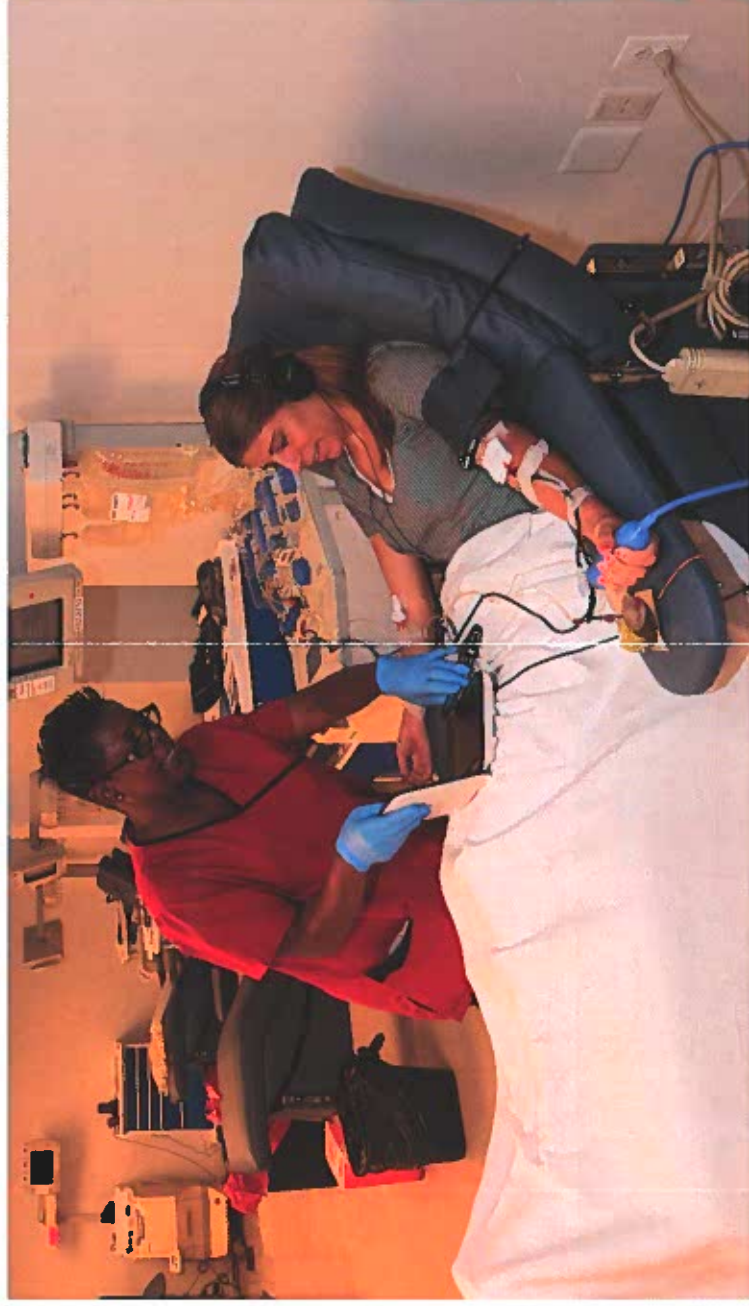
...when a family escapes a fire safely due to the smoke alarms and escape plans put into place by teams of Red Cross volunteers.
