- 559 million people speak Spanish today
- There are 21 countries that have Spanish as the official language.
- Spanish is the 2nd most spoken language in the world today!
- Spanish is the second-most studied language in the world
- According to the United States Census Bureau, the Spanish-speaking population in the United States will reach 132.8 million by 2050, and this country will become the largest Spanish-speaking country.


## Courses offered

Spanish is taken every other day, over the course of one semester, during a student's 8th grade year. It is taken as an exploratory course, giving the students a "taste" of what learning Spanish is all about. Students then have the option to select Spanish as an elective, beginning their 9th grade year; levels I-IV are offered at Rockwood.
