

The Rockwood Area Board of School Directors held its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, March 21, 2023.

The minutes of the committee meeting on 2/21/2023 and the regular meeting on 2/21/2023 were approved.

The agenda, agenda items, and additional agenda items were approved.

The Board approved the financial and treasurer reports, bills, and budgetary transfers as presented.

#### **Old Business:**

The Board approved the Rockwood Area School District Health and Safety Plan.

#### **New Business:**

The Board approved the Appalachia IU08 General Fund Operating Budget for the 2023-2024 fiscal year.

Sherry Benford distributed and collected the ballots for the election of Appalachia IU08 Board of Directors.

The Board approved the renewal agreement with Metz Culinary Management for the 2023-2024 school year.

The Board approved the purchase of additional cafeteria equipment using cafeteria funds.

The Board approved revisions to the Rockwood Area School District Course Selection Guide for the 2023-2024 school year.

The Board voted in favor to accept the Rockwood Area Mental Health & Safety/Security Grant, in the amount of \$220,742.00, approve all grant funded activities, and authorize the Business Office to advertise for a Student Services Support Specialist to employ for the duration of the grant funding period.

The Board accepted Somerset Engineering's Contractors Recommendation for award of each of the prime contracts for General Construction, Plumbing, Electrical, and Mechanical for the Proposed Restroom and Locker Room Alterations Project and to award corresponding bids as follows:

## **Superintendent's Report:**

Mark Bower reviewed the Rockwood Area School District Facilities and Program's Needs-Assessment and discussed immediate needs as well as potential, future needs.

Mark Bower informed the Board that the addition of a School Police Office has been a tremendous asset to the district and has received a lot of positive feedback.

Mark Bower advised the Board that the application to offer a Flexible Instructional Day (FID) program during the 2023-2024 school year must be submitted by June 1, 2023.

Mark Bower informed the Board that the Pre-K Counts Letter of Intent was completed and submitted to PDE. Grant funding will not be awarded until after a final State budget is approved.

Jon Hale advised the Board that kindergarten registration went well. As of now, 34 children have registered. He thanked Cindy Miller and other staff members who assisted with the registration process.

Jon Hale informed the Board that staffing for the elementary and class sizes are looking adequate for the 2023-2024 school year.

Jon Hale updated the Board on elementary programs, events, and end of year activities. The elementary Geography Bee went well and was well attended by parents. The Leaders of Tomorrow incentive program, which rewards positive behavior, has been very successful this year. A 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade dance, sponsored by elementary student council, will be held on April 5<sup>th</sup> during the school day.

Misty Demchak recognized individual students for their personal achievements and informed the Board of high school events, athletics, and upcoming activities, such as:

- Three students will be attending the Regional Band Festival on March 23 & 24.
- The Mobile Oil Field Learning Unit (MOLU) is scheduled to be at the school on April 13.

- SATs will be given to selected students at the school on March 22.
- Homecoming for the 2023-2024 school year is scheduled for Saturday, September 23, with activities being coordinated by Student Council.
- The Mobile Ag Lab will be at the school during the week of March 27 31, with special thanks to Mrs. Leanna Weimer for coordinating this opportunity.
- The HVAC program will be returning to SCTC.
- The scheduling process for students in grades 7-12 has begun.

Misty Demchak read a letter from the musical staff and cast. They thanked the Board for their continued support of the program.

Megan Hetrick advised the Board of the need to fill two vacant special education teaching positions, beginning the 2023-2024 school year.

Jordan Svonavec informed the Board that the Pennsylvania Association of School Business Officials (PASBO) conference he attended in March was very beneficial. He gained a lot of valuable information.
