



## Creative Cooking Guidelines and Expectations

**Course Description:** (Grades 10 – 12) Catering: Students will learn simple techniques for entertaining guests for casual or formal theme parties. Students will organize a catering plan for a special theme and put their actual catering plans into action. This class is a great opportunity to use your own creativity to prepare a variety of entrees. (.5 credit)

**Expectations:** Each student should

1. Be seated when the bell rings
2. Be prepared for class with folder and writing utensil before the bell rings.
3. Be attentive when the teacher is talking.
4. Not cause any type of classroom disruptions (especially during group work).
5. Show respect to other classmates and instructor.
6. Make up all class work when absent and turn in assignments on due date for credit.
7. Have a positive attitude (manners and language).

**Course Requirements:**

1. Complete all written assignments (in class and homework).

3. Complete creative projects, posters, and any book work.
4. Participate in class food labs, clothing labs, and computer lab activities.
5. Incomplete assignments will result in non-participation of food labs.
6. Failure to comply with classroom rules will result in disciplinary offense/ actions.

1. Plan and implement catering recipes and décor.
2. Prepare a variety of recipes.
3. Written course work and tests for each unit.
4. Cake competition.
5. Meal planning.
