What's More Important?

The arguments that the people had over whether or not the Constitution should be ratified can still be seen today. People still question what is more important:

A strong national government that has the power to protect the security of the country

OR

Are the rights of individuals more important

You have to ask yourself the following – Do you want the country to be able to do *whatever it takes* to protect itself and you?

OR

As Ben Franklin stated **"They who can give up essential liberty to obtain a little temporary safety deserve neither liberty nor safety."** Is it worth living in a society that is not entirely free or can't guarantee your freedoms? Do you want to live in a society where the government can watch your every move?

- Remember that your privacy rights and freedoms are similar to your freedom of speech
 - It depends on location and what you are doing
 - Think about how much privacy from the government you should have when you (or your personal property) are located in the following locations
 - Your home
 - In your car
 - In public
 - While using a personal technology device
 - Cell phone (including it's contents like pictures and messages)
 - Internet searches
 - Email
 - Social media
 - Gaming system
 - Online apps & games
